Bradley International Airport and Paradies Lagardère Partner to Add New Concessions, Upgrade Others

Windsor Locks (July 12, 2023) – The Connecticut Airport Authority is pleased to announce that its partner and award-winning airport concessionaire Paradies Lagardère will be upgrading its existing establishments at Bradley International Airport and adding two new dining concepts.

Currently, at Bradley International Airport, Paradies Lagardère operates six retail locations. They include two CNBC Stores, two New England Travelmarts, one iStore, and one Avanti Marketplace.

As part of the upcoming upgrades, Paradies Lagardère will be updating all six concepts. Four will be refreshed within their existing brand. Two concepts will reopen under a new name, including CT River Landing and Charter Oak Emporium.

In addition, a much sought after Starbucks will be introduced. This will be the airport's first Starbucks post-TSA screening, located in the food court area.

A sit-down restaurant, called Beercode Kitchen & Bar, is also planned for the Gates 20-30 concourse, which currently does not offer a sit-down option. The restaurant is a unique, gastropub-style concept offering a wide array of cuisine for breakfast, lunch and dinner, and an eclectic lineup of local craft beer and other beverages.

"We are truly excited to enhance our successful retail stores as well as add the iconic Starbucks and Beercode restaurants to our overall program at Bradley International Airport," said Gregg Paradies, President and CEO of Paradies Lagardère. "We appreciate the Connecticut Airport Authority's partnership over the years and look forward to continually serving their travelers with these exciting new options in the airport."
